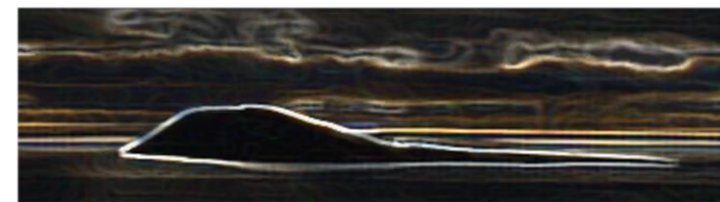

Naomi said, 'It has been a privilege to live in such a beautiful part of the world and to grow in my ministry as I've worked in the communities in Bro Enlli. But curacies inevitably come to an end, and I am delighted to have the opportunity to join the team in Bro Dwynwen. I am looking forward to getting to know that part of Anglesey - and to see where God is leading us as we seek to build his kingdom.'

Janet Fletcher will come to Bro Enlli. Living in Aberdaron, Janet will serve all of our Ministry Area as part of the Ministry team. She will continue with her work as Spiritual Officer to the Bangor Diocese as well as develop and strengthen the Pilgrim Ministry on the Llyn between Bangor and Bardsey island.

Janet said "It was a wonderful surprise to be asked to become the Associate Vicar in Bro Enlli. I am looking forward to this next step in my ministry, and to discover what I can bring to the ministry area. Moving to Aberdaron, I hope to explore the work of R.S Thomas and Jim Cotter more, to see how they can further inspire me in my own writing"
